Date: October 1, 2014

The National Transit Institute (NTI) will be presenting a FREE course (\$450 for consulting, contractors, consulting, non-profit or Government agencies) concerning **“Introduction to Transit Service Planning”** in Louisville, Kentucky on October 20-22, 2014 and Seattle, Washington on December 15-17, 2014.

This course seeks to have participants understand public transit service planning. By the end of the course, participants will be able to undertake conceptual service planning/design and redesign, including routing and scheduling, transit budgeting, and calculating levels of service and capacity.
