
By letter dated November 21, 2006, I advised your client, Akron Metro Regional Transit Authority, regarding the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) imposition of a \$415,325 monetary penalty for engaging in a pattern of violations of FTA's charter service regulation. I stated that the authorized disbursement of Fiscal Years 2007 and 2008 urbanized area formula grant funds available to Metro would be reduced by a total of \$415,325, divided into two equal parts for the next two fiscal years.

I have reviewed your February 26, 2007, request for reconsideration of the withholding schedule. You requested that the funds be withheld over a four year period in four equal amounts. You further requested that the funds withheld from Metro be distributed to the Portage Area Regional Transit Authority (PARTA).

In the spirit of compromise, I will authorize that the disbursement of Fiscal Years 2007-2009 urbanized area formula grant funds available to Metro be reduced by a total of \$415,325 divided into three equal parts for the next three fiscal years. I will not, however, distribute the withheld funds to PARTA so that they remain in the Akron Urbanized Area.
