As you may be aware, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Prevention recently announced the availability of \$100 million to support Community Transformation Grants, created by the Affordable Care Act (ACA). The funding is available to support evidence- and practice-based community and clinical prevention and wellness strategies that will lead to specific, measurable health outcomes to reduce chronic disease rates.


